



4 in 10 (45%) of Chicagoans have received at least a first dose of vaccine


More than half (56%) of Chicagoans 18+ have received at least a first dose of vaccine



Breakthrough Cases (in Vaccinated People)

- More than 700,000 Chicagoans have a completed vaccine series
- 468 breakthrough cases identified as of 4/26/21(0.06%) of those with completed series)
 - 48 hospitalizations (cause of hospitalizations still under review; median age: 72y, range 24-97y)
 - 5 deaths (1 in 50s, 2 in 60s, 2 70y+)



SARS-CoV-2 variant surveillance* – Emergent Variants of Concern (VOC) identified in Chicago residents







Geographic Distribution of Known Variant Cases

Distribution of variant cases is only a reflection of the providers submitting specimens and laboratories performing genomic sequencing

We do not know the true extent to which variants of SARS-CoV-2 are spreading in Chicago

However, based on investigation of cases, we do know that variants of concern are spreading from person-to-person in our communities




