## REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL FOR CHICAGO'S CENTRALIZED WAY TAXICAB DISPATCH SERVICE

The City of Chicago's Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection (BACP) is seeking an interested and eligible contractor to operate the City of Chicago's Centralized Wheelchair Accessible Vehicle (WAV) Taxicab Dispatch Service. BACP invites the submission of proposals in response to its Request for Proposals (RFP) for the operation of a centralized dispatch service for City of Chicago licensed wheelchair accessible vehicle (WAV) taxicabs.

The <u>RFP FOR THE CHICAGO CENTRALIZED WAV TAXICAB DISPATCH SERVICE</u> is available at <u>Chicago.gov/PublicVehicles</u> - click on <u>Chicago Wheelchair Accessible Taxicabs (WAV)</u>.

- The purpose of the RFP is to identify an entity to provide such dispatch services, which, in addition to providing a means of summoning WAV taxicabs by telephone, will include the ability to hail WAV taxicabs electronically.
- The selected Respondent will be contracted to provide a centralized dispatch service for WAV taxicab vehicles as defined in the RFP.
- The goal of the Centralized WAV Taxicab Dispatch Service is to ensure a swift response to a passenger's request for WAV taxicab service by timely connecting the passenger with a City licensed WAV taxicab.
- BACP is seeking Respondents to provide onsite (Chicago based location) management; technology and equipment; and oversight and coordination of the Centralized Wheelchair Accessible Vehicle (WAV) Taxicab Dispatch Service.
- Pursuant to Municipal Code of Chicago Section 9-112-570 "Taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicles and centralized wheelchair accessible dispatch", the BACP Commissioner is authorized to regulate a centralized dispatch system for wheelchair accessible vehicle taxicabs.
