

Charges Filed with the Police Board

The following charges have been filed with the Police Board by the Superintendent of Police. The public is reminded that the filing of charges is not evidence of guilt. The accused officer is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair hearing at which the Superintendent has the burden of proving guilt by a preponderance of the evidence.

CHARGES AGAINST POLICE OFFICER SHAWN BRYANT

Police Officer Shawn Bryant, Star Number 4142, is charged with violating the following rules contained in Article V of the Rules and Regulations of the Chicago Police Department, which were in full force and effect on the date of the alleged violations:

- Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.
- Rule 3: Any failure to promote the Department's efforts to implement its policy or accomplish its goals.
- Rule 6: Disobedience of an order or directive, whether written or oral.
- Rule 9: Engaging in any unjustified verbal or physical altercation with any person, while on or off duty.
- Rule 38: Unlawful or unnecessary use or display of a weapon.


SPECIFICATIONS

1. On or about March 9, 2018, at or near 7221 South Merrill Avenue, in Chicago, Illinois, Police Officer Shawn Bryant discharged his firearm at or in the direction of Anthony Brown. Officer Bryant's use of force was not necessary to prevent death or great bodily harm from an imminent threat posed to him or another person. Nor was the use of deadly force necessary to prevent an arrest from being defeated because Brown did not pose an imminent threat of death or great bodily harm to Officer Bryant or anyone else unless he was arrested without delay. Officer Bryant thereby
 - a. Engaged in any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department, in violation of Rule 2, and/or
 - b. Failed to promote the Department's efforts to implement its policy or accomplish its goals, in violation of Rule 3, and/or
 - c. Disobeyed an order or directive, whether written or oral (General Order 03-02 - Use of Force, and/or General Order 03-02-03 - Firearms Discharge Incidents Involving Sworn Members, and/or General Order 03-02-01 - Force Options) in violation of Rule 6, and/or
 - d. Engaged in any unjustified verbal or physical altercation with any person, while on or off duty, in violation of Rule 9, and/or
 - e. Unlawfully or unnecessarily used or displayed a weapon, in violation of Rule 38.

2. On or about March 9, 2018, at or near 7221 South Merrill Avenue, in Chicago, Illinois, Police Officer Shawn Bryant failed to fully load his forcar, which is required. Officer Bryant thereby
 - a. Engaged in any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department, in violation of Rule 2, and/or
 - b. Failed to promote the Department's efforts to implement its policy or accomplish its goals, in violation of Rule 3, and/or
 - c. Disobeyed an order or directive, whether written or oral (Uniform and Property U04-02 - Department Approved Weapons and Ammunition) in violation of Rule 6.

3. On or about March 9, 2018, at or near 7221 South Merrill Avenue, in Chicago, Illinois, Police Officer Shawn Bryant failed to activate his body worn camera in a timely manner. Officer Bryant thereby
 - a. Engaged in any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department, in violation of Rule 2, and/or
 - b. Failed to promote the Department's efforts to implement its policy or accomplish its goals, in violation of Rule 3, and/or
 - c. Disobeyed an order or directive, whether written or oral (Special Order 03-14 – Body Worn Cameras) in violation of Rule 6.

Based on the foregoing charges and specifications, the Superintendent recommends that Officer Shawn Bryant, Star Number 4142, be separated from the Chicago Police Department.
