ATTENDANCE AT BOARD MEETINGS BY AUDIO OR VIDEO CONFERENCE

Pursuant to the requirements of the Illinois Open Meetings Act (5 ILCS 120), the Police Board adopts the following rules regarding Board members' attendance at Board meetings by audio or video conference.

- 1. If a Board member wishes to attend a closed or open Board meeting by audio or video conference, the member must notify the Board's executive director before the meeting unless advance notice is impractical.
- 2. If a quorum of the members of the Board is physically present at the location of the meeting, a majority of the Board may allow a member to attend the meeting by audio or video conference if the member is prevented from physically attending because of: (a) personal illness or disability; (b) employment purposes or the business of the public body; or (c) a family or other emergency; or (d) unexpected childcare obligations.
