1	\$61,800
2	\$70,600
3	\$79,450
4	\$88,250
5	\$95,350

- 1-4 owner-occupied properties
 (Note: condos, mixed-use properties,
 5+ unit properties do not qualify.)
- Must be the owner's primary and only residence.
- Homeowners who earn up to 80% of the Area Median Income (AMI). See chart for income qualifications.

This program will be delivered by Zero Homes and Elevate. Homeowners can expect to be contacted directly after eligibility is verified.
