## Dear Ms. Worthington:

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) has reviewed the *Response to IEPA Comments and the Remedial Action Plan* (received February 2, 2024/Log No. 24-77742), as prepared by Carnow, Conibear & Assoc., Ltd., for the Site Remediation Project located at 3001-11 West Fifth Avenue, Chicago, Illinois. The document referenced above has been conditionally approved with the following comments.

- 1. As indicated on the current DRM-2 Form, the Remedial Applicant company name, contact person, and address differ from the DRM-1 Form. Based on the change of the Remedial Applicant information, please submit a new DRM-1 Form.
- 2. The proposed alternative engineered barrier consisting of a minimum of 18 inches of imported clean fill underlain by a geotextile fabric (Mirafi® 180N) is approved. Adequate information should be provided demonstrating that the alternative barrier has been installed.
- 3. The Tier 3 evaluation to utilize updated background levels for inorganics has been approved.
- 4. The Illinois EPA anticipates receipt of a Remedial Action Completion Report (RACR). The RACR should provide all supporting documentation (disposal tickets, engineered barrier photographs, etc.). The RACR must address the applicable requirements of 35 IAC Part 740.455 and 35 IAC Part 742.

Please submit two (2) copies of all future reports or correspondence to the Illinois EPA regarding this site. If you have any questions I may be contacted at the address or telephone number listed above.

Item 2 of your letter states that an alternative engineered barrier of 18 inches of clean imported fill underlain by a geotextile fabric (Mirafi 180N) is approved.
