## BOARD FINES COMPANY FOR RETAINING UNREGISTERED LOBBYIST

On October 29, 2019, the Board notified Elgin Sweeping Services, Inc. that it determined there was probable cause to believe that in 2015, the company violated §2-156-305 of the Governmental Ethics Ordinance because an individual employed, retained, hired, or authorized by it failed to register as required by §2-156-245 of the Ordinance. Without admitting or denying the allegation, Elgin Sweeping agreed to pay a fine of \$2,000, the maximum fine allowable under law, to resolve the matter, which is Case No. 19018.L.E. At its December 6, 2019 meeting the Board voted 4-0 to accept the company's payment of \$2,000.
