

THE CHICAGO DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY AND SUPPORT SERVICES SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

DFSS, with funding from the Community Services Block Grant, will award scholarships to eligible students for the fall semester of 2024 to cover the cost of tuition, vocational training, and other approved post-secondary education expenses at accredited institutions.

Scholarships range from \$1,000 to \$5,000 for income-eligible residents.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be City of Chicago resident, who meets the income eligibility requirements.
- Must be a high school graduate (or equivalent) enrolled in at least 12 credit hours of classes at an accredited post-secondary institution during the fall semester/quarter of 2024.
- Must demonstrate academic achievement, career potential, and educational motivation.
