Alderperson Mitts asked for a list of youth community engagement efforts.

DTI has engaged in numerous community engagement efforts in 2024, including several engagements with Chicago youth. Please find the below list detailing these engagements.

- CIO Nick Lucius joined as a member of the Chicago City Colleges Advisory council
- CIO Nick Lucius attended Brentano Math and Science Academy to discuss technology in Chicago Public Schools on behalf of Mayor Johnson during the first week of school in August
- DTI visited XChange, a program established by vendor partner SDI Presence, to learn about how the city's IT vendors are investing locally in workforce development and neighborhood revitalization efforts
- DTI's senior leadership attended the series of Budget Engagement events led by the Mayor's Office to obtain direct public input on the budget proposal
- DTI CIO and staff regularly attend <u>Chi Hack Night</u>, a weekly event focused on civic improvement projects through data, design and technology
- DTI participated with <u>GET Cities</u> to discuss inclusive technology initiatives and increase equity in the technology industry
- DTI Executive Director Roderick Warren attended Take Back the Block events in partnership with the Mayor's Office of Community Safety to foster community engagement

DTI leadership and staff visited migrant shelters to observe operations and understand how DTI can support departments in their service delivery, including DFSS
