Alderman La Spata asked what does the \$140,000 For Professional and Technical Services and Other Third Party Benefit Agreements, Line 0140 on page 303 cover.

Account 0140 covers expenditures for professional services provided by (1) **hearing officers** who preside over police disciplinary cases, and (2) **appeals officers** who review and make recommendations on appeals filed by disqualified applicants for the position of Chicago police officer.
