Corted their energy use in 2021,

87% of large buildings reported their energy use in 2021, up from 85% in 2020.



• IMPACT AND OPPORTUNITY

The median carbon emissions per square foot (GHG intensity) from reporting properties are down by **37%** since **2016**. Energy use per sq. ft. (also known as Energy Use Intensity) for buildings reporting in the last three consecutive years 2019-2021) has dropped by **7%**.

The Chicago Energy Rating System was impleneted in 2019 to increase awareness of energy use. Building owners are required to display a placard illustrating their building's energy performance on an annual basis to the general public. Approximately 39% of buildings received a four out of four-star rating in 2021. Chicago is proud to have been the first city in the nation to require this kind of transparency.
