








Q6: How do you feel about your business outlook for 2024?



Q7: What does your hiring outlook look like in 2024?




Q8: In the past year, have you had difficulty filling job openings?




Q9: Have any of these factors challenged your ability to attract and retain employees?










Q16: Do existing City of Chicago programs and incentives meet your business needs?



Q17: How willing would your company be to partner with local institutions to improve local hiring?






Q21: What are your top three (3) reasons you keep your business in Chicago?
