

EMERGENCY SUPPLEMENTAL VICTIMS FUND



AVAILABLE NOW:

Victims and families of victims and who have experienced gunshot wounds or homicide may be eligible to receive financial assistance to alleviate the immediate financial impact of a violence incident.

AVAILABLE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

- Basic needs (\$1,000)
- Funeral Expenses (\$1,500)
- Relocation Expenses (\$1,000 for temporary or permanent)

ELIGIBILITY:

- Victims or families of victims who have experienced gunshot wounds or all-cause homicide within the calendar year.
- Incident occurred in one (1) of the 15 community areas listed.
- Families of homicide victims aged 24 or younger.
- Victim and applicant must have proof of City of Chicago residence.

DISPONIBLE ACTUALMENTE:

Las víctimas y sus familiares que han sufrido herida de bala o han perdido a un ser querido por homicidio, pueden ser elegibles para recibir asistencia económica para aliviar el impacto financiero tras un incidente violento.

ASISTENCIA ECONÓMICA DISPONIBLE:

- Necesidades básicas (\$1,000)
- Gastos funerarios (\$1,500)
- Gastos de reubicación (\$1,000) para reubicaciones temporales o permanentes)

ELEGIBILIDAD:

- Víctimas de herida de bala o familiares que hayan perdido a un ser querido por homicidio.
- en una de las 15 comunidades mencionadas.
- Familiares de víctimas de homicidio menores a los 24 años de edad.
- La víctima y el solicitante deben tener prueba de residencia en la Ciudad de Chicago.
