

X Strategy Objectives

- Streamline internally and move forward with a strong all-city response to address community safety in each designated area
- Engage community partners to co-create approaches to address violence
- Breakdown incidents at the beat level to analyze violence trends and to coordinate collective responses
- Identify any gaps and needs that are necessary to support this work
- Establish a weekly cadence for meetings
- Sustain this work with high intensity throughout the summer


